

#### Daniel 9:1-2




#### Daniel 9:3-4


#### Daniel 9:13

#### Daniel 9:18-19

We do not make requests of you because we are righteous, but because of your great mercy. <sup>19</sup> Lord, listen! Lord, forgive! Lord, hear and act! For your sake, my God, do not delay..."
